Expectations and Conduct

Thank you for participating in our Future Stars program, specifically designed for the 6-9 year old player. Feel free to contact the director with any questions you may have. For those of you that are new to the program, or are guest players, please review the following information:

FUTURE STARS philosophy on trainings and games

Trainings and Games for players of this age should be a fun, organized, learning experience. Winning is not the focus. Technical and tactical development is.

One of our goals in the FUTURE STARS PROGRAM is to develop the 'Total Soccer Player'. In keeping with that goal, players will be exposed to all positions, including GoalKeeper.

Player Expectations

- Arrive a few minutes early to trainings and at least 30 minutes early for games ready to warm up.
- Always bring water, ball, & appropriate clothing for the weather.
- Wear FUTURE STARS T-shirt, Black shorts, and white socks to all games and training sessions.
- **Have fun! Never force your son/daughter to attend.**

Parent Expectations

- Once your child arrives at a FUTURE STARS session or game, he/she will be in the hands of our coaching staff. Coaching from the sideline is **not allowed** by parents during games or training sessions. It often conflicts with what we have told them to work on, and ultimately this only distracts the players, and diminishes the 'Fun Factor'.
- In games cheer for every player, even if they are not the best player. Never criticize a player.
- For outdoor games, teams and their coaches will be on one side of the field, with parents and spectators on the opposite side (this will help keep players and coaches from being distracted).
- At games, **Absolutely no arguing with the referee!** We as adults need to set the example for the players.
- **Enjoy the game!! (whether they win or lose).**
