GRADIN COMMUNITY SPORTS PARK GRAND OPENING

Yes, the long awaited Gradin Community Sports Park grand opening is finally here!! On behalf of the City of Gresham, Verizon, Gresham Little League and EastSide United FC, the community event to commemorate the new sports park will be held **Saturday, June 20th from 11am – 2pm**. Gradin Community Sports Park is located at 2303 SE Palmquist Rd. Bring the whole family and partake in the speed pitch booth, batting cages, soccer clinics, the ESUFC Fall soccer registration table, giveaways and concessions while checking out phase I of the 32.3 acre park. Phase I completion includes 2 soccer and 2 softball fields with all fields fenced and irrigated; paved parking lot which provides parking for 220 cars; bike parking; handicap accessibility; and a water fountain. A one-mile walking path has also been installed by Gresham Wednesday Lunchtime Rotary. As funding becomes available, the master plan will provide 2 additional soccer fields and 2 additional softball fields, 7 picnic shelters, 3 play structures, 2 half court basketball courts, horseshoe courts, skate park, 2 concession/restroom buildings, a 35,000 square foot community building and 240 additional on-site parking spaces. What a dynamic addition to the community. The city of Gresham, EastSide United FC and Gradin Community Sports Park – a winning combination!!

DON'T WAIT – IT'S TIME TO REGISTER FOR FALL SOCCER!!!!

ESUFC Recreational Fall League is available for children U5 through U18 who wish to learn skills while playing the game of soccer purely for the fun of it! This league is a genuine non-competitive recreational league where children are taught the game of soccer through practices and soccer matches.

For your convenience we offer ESUFC Fall League choices:

ESUFC – Gresham: Practices and all games (for U5 – U8) and all home games (for U9 – U14) held within the Gresham area.

ESUFC – Sandy/Welches: Practices and all games (for U5 – U8) and all home games (for U9 – U14) held within the Sandy area and, if practical and **contingent on Welches player/coach registration numbers**, held within the Welches area.

ESUFC – Clackamas: Practices and all games (for U5 – U8) held at Happy Valley Park.

ESUFC High School Coed 7v7: Practices and all games (for U16/U18) are held within the Gresham area and all games will be played on the turf fields of either Sam Barlow or Gresham High Schools. This new ESUFC league is open to all high schoolers interested in recreational soccer.

- All ESUFC U5, U6, U7 and U16/U18 play coed along with U8's in ESUFC-Sandy/Welches and ESUFC-Clackamas.
- U5-U8 teams play locally (Gresham, Sandy/Welches and Happy Valley Park)
- U9/10 teams travel between Gresham and Sandy/Welches
- U11-14 teams play in the CRYSA league which incorporates East County Portland and The Dalles/Hood River.
- U16/U18 combined play in the newly developed ESUFC High School Coed 7v7 league.

Children must be 4 years of age or older on or before July 31, 2009 in order to play in the fall season. If new to EastSide United FC, you must provide a copy of the player's birth certificate.

REGISTER ON-LINE NOW On-line registration for ESUFC Fall Recreation League is now available and **we strongly encourage all members to register on-line.** It's fast, safe and the most economical registration option. You can choose to pay on-line using a credit card at no extra cost or you may choose to mail or bring your payment in. To register a player and also to register to coach go to www.esufc.com.

U16 /U18 players: Because the high school coed season starts later than the younger age groups, and because the high school coed does not participate in ESUFC group practice dates or jamboree, **ESUFC will accept U16/U18 registrations through August 28 without late fees.**

When you have registered for ESUFC Fall Recreation successfully you will then receive an email registration confirmation receipt along with a registration/medical form. Be sure to check your SPAM file for this also. **If you do not receive this receipt then this means you did not register successfully and will not be in our system as a registrant.** If you are experiencing problems, please contact the ESUFC office at 503.667.8312.

*If you have participated in any ESUFC event in the last year, you then already have a username and password in our system. Use this same username and password when registering on-line for fall league. If you do not remember your username and password, please contact ESUFC at 503-667-8312 or chris@esufc.com.

FYI – Our teams fill up fast so don't be left standing on the sidelines – REGISTER EARLY!! We hope you can join the ESUFC family for a phenomenal soccer season of learning, camaraderie, and most importantly – FUN!!

*Registrations received after 7/22/09 (U16/U18 are exempt) may be placed on a waiting list and buddy requests, school ties or prior fall team placement may not be honored dependent on team space availability.

- A \$5 discount is given for each additional child registered from the same immediate family up to (3) children.
- As a gift to our membership the first registrant in a family will receive (2) Timbers tickets for the September 3rd home game against the Rochester Raging Rhinos. Each additional registrant from the same family will receive (1) ticket (up to 3 children).
- As payment, ESUFC will accept cash, check and debit/credit.
- On-line registrants may pay with debit/credit on-line or choose to mail or bring payment into the ESUFC office. **Be sure to click the "finish" button on the final financial page of the registration.**
- Walk-in registrants must pay at time of registration.
- No registrant will be placed until full payment is received by ESUFC.
- Any players not paid in full two weeks from when they registered will be dropped unless arrangements are made with office.
- Late registrations (received after 7/7/09; or for U16/18 after 8/28/09) and refunds will incur a \$13 processing fee and no refunds will be issued after Jamboree.
- Any returned checks will be subject to a \$25 NSF charge.

ESUFC Uniform Kit Fees

All players are required to wear the appropriate uniform ensemble for their designated age group. No new uniform kit purchase is necessary if your child has one that fits from a previous season and that is still appropriate for the age group your child is registered to play in. For those needing to purchase a new uniform, please see the uniform price chart below:

- **U5 YXS Uniform Kits - \$25 (must be registered in U5 age group)...**The U5 kit comes in **youth extra small only** and is comprised of (1) red "HOME" and (1) white "AWAY" ESUFC logo t-shirts; (1) black pair adidas shorts; (1) white pair adidas socks.
- **U6 – U14 Uniform Kits - \$40.....**The U6 – U14 kit runs youth small through adult extra large and is comprised of (1) red "HOME" and (1) white "AWAY" adidas jerseys; (1) black pair adidas shorts; (1) white pair adidas socks.
- **U16 /U18 High School Coed Uniform Kits – No Cost.....**The U16/U18 uniform kit consists of (1) red "HOME" and (1) white "AWAY" ESUFC logo t-shirts and (1) white pair adidas socks with the cost already included in the registration fee. Players are responsible for black shorts.

TEAM FORMATION - How ESUFC forms teams differs between age groups:

- **U5, U6, and U7 coaches** are allowed (2) freezes, one of which would include their own child and another that would include the child of a possible assistant coach. The remainder of the player slots open on the teams are then filled with buddy requests and then school ties when practical and finally random draws from the player pool, in that order.
- **U8 coaches and new U9 – U14 coaches** are allowed (5) freezes, one of which would include their own child and another that would include the child of a possible assistant coach. The remaining player slots open on the team are then filled from the player pool using schools and buddy requests when possible. Buddy requests do apply to freezes noted above. Buddies of "freezes" are considered a freeze also so 1 freeze with a buddy now becomes 2 freezes.
- **Established U9 – U14 teams** will keep their teams together from last fall as long as the previous coach returns to coach the team. Any open roster spots will be filled via random draws from the player pool. **Buddy requests can only be honored for those players in the player pool – not for those players currently on an established team.**
- **High School Coed teams** will not be formed until the first two weeks in September. The High School Coed 7v7 recreational season runs from mid-September to early November. High school coed teams will be formed through ESUFC-Gresham only. We must have a minimum of (40) players and (4) coaches registered to form (4) teams which is needed to play in this 7v7 league.

Parent/Player Requests: The **ONLY** requests accepted are:

Coach Freezes

Player/Buddy Requests – only (1) reciprocal buddy request per player except as noted above for existing U9 – U14 teams.

Parent Request To Place Player Back Into The Player Pool

Parent Request **Not** To Have Player Placed With A Certain Coach Or Player

***ESUFC will not honor any carpooling requests, coach requests, or any other requests not listed above.**

Player/Buddy Request: If (2) players would like to play on the same team, we will do our best to make this arrangement. In order for this to take place, **BOTH** players must make the request to play together (player "A" requests to play with player "B" and player "B" requests to play with player "A"). Each player must include their buddy's first **AND** last name on their registration. **Players may only request (1) buddy and both players must be registered on or before July 7.** ESUFC must be in receipt of full payment for the buddy request to be honored. See note regarding established U9 – U14 teams with regards to the buddy rule.

***Player/Buddy requests may not be honored if registering late (after 7/7/09).**

COACHES REQUIREMENTS - Interested in volunteering to coach for ESUFC? You must first:

Register as a coach or assistant coach with ESUFC on-line at www.esufc.com

Fill out and pass a background/disclosure check

Agree to and sign a Coaches Code of Conduct

Then you must –

Participate in an ESUFC age appropriate coaching module training

Participate in a National Youth Sports Coaches Association (NYSCA) coach certification class offered by ESUFC for those coaches not holding a current NYSCA certification

Attend a mandatory coaches meeting **required of all past and new coaches**

New Parent Meeting & Group Practices

After registering my player what is the next step? After successfully registering and making payment with ESUFC, the next time we will see you will be for group practices and, if you are new to ESUFC, the new parent meeting.

Parents: ESUFC requires that each parent new to the club attend a mandatory parent meeting. We will share our mission statement and explain the club's soccer philosophy to new members. ESUFC will also outline the expectations of the club for the coaches, the players, and the parents. All parents will be required to sign a Parent Code of Conduct.

Players: Your first practice will be a group practice. This is also when you will meet your coach and teammates and when you may pick up your uniform kit, if one was ordered, and Timbers tickets. At the end of the group practices, your child's team coach will communicate with you information about your teams' days, times and location for practices.

EASTSIDE UNITED FC FUTURE STARS

If your 7-9 year old son or daughter is a soccer fanatic, then we have an opportunity for them. Our **Future Stars, a U8-U10 development program**, is for boys and girls who love soccer and wish to learn more about the game. They learn to improve their ball skills and tactical awareness through coordination exercises, relays and games. We also introduce soccer specific dynamic (movement) stretching and ACL preventative training. Future Stars provides a safe and fun environment for the players to practice and play under the guidance of some of the finest coaches, trainers and teachers of the game in the state of Oregon. This often can be a spring board for players with classic aspirations. Future Stars is not a replacement to your recreation program, but a supplement to it.

Future Stars is a year round program designed for your convenience. **Starting June 2nd**, our summer program provides players the options of training 2 times per week in 2 different locations. **Our trainings are generally from 6-7:30pm on Tuesdays at Happy Valley Park and Fridays at Gresham High School.** Players can attend as many training sessions as they like, when they like. Each age group will practice in gender specific groups where we encourage all players to play without any fear of making mistakes and to express themselves positively on the soccer field. Our coaches challenge all of the players to get better and improve and in the process, encourage sportsmanship and good values.

The FIRST Future Stars training is free and we encourage all to come and experience what is offered. After that we know your child will want to attend again. The program uses a punch card system that comes in easy to purchase **bundles of 8 sessions (\$60), 16 sessions (\$110), and 24 sessions (\$155).** We do not expect every player to attend all trainings, but would love it if they did. Each player's punch card will be waiting for them every time they arrive to check in.
